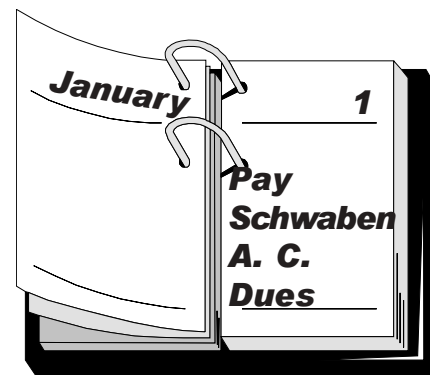


FROM THE DUES COLLECTOR.....Margo Schon

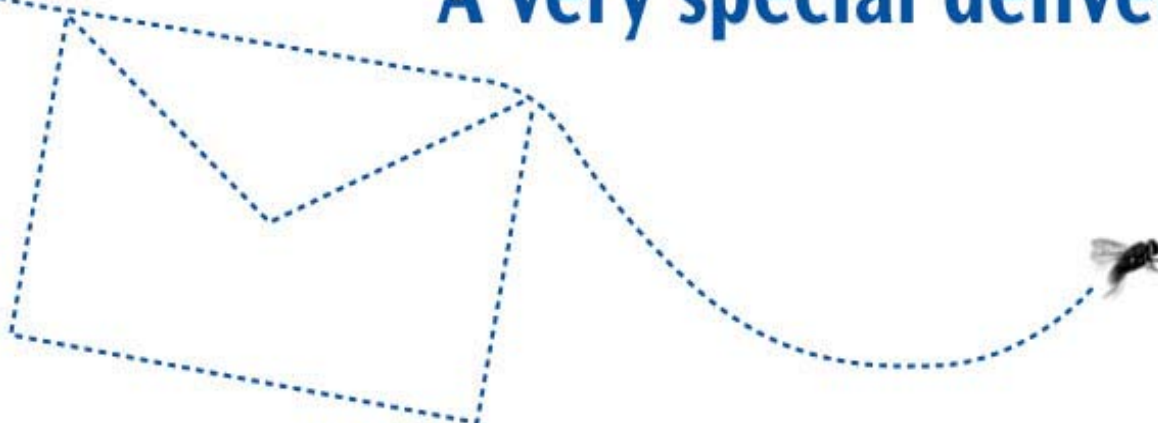
